On Site WH&S Policy and Procedures COVID19

Issued 23rd March 2020

Overview:

This document has been designed as a tool to use in conjunction with all the COVID19 notifications that have been issued and the existing everyday site procedures. It is important that you understand that this is a guide to maintaining good health practices for the safety of you and others.

On Site:

Prior to entering a site

- Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water as issued in your vehicle;
- Follow sites instruction in relation to COVID19 Health and Safety;
- Use the sites hand sanitizer at entry;
- Use your OWN pen to sign in;
- Use your OWN pen to push any buttons on keyboards to data entry;
- or use the supplied sanitizer;
- or use appropriate PPE;
- Use the appropriate PPE when required;
- Cover your mouth with your elbow when coughing or use a clean tissue;
- Abide by social distancing when working with others 1.5mtrs distance or 4sqmtrs

Completion of works

- Sign out using your own pen;
- Or the supplied sanitizer;
- No signature required on Connect Name & Surname and VP Number is sufficient at this point;
- Wash hands at your vehicle with soap and water

Staff Management

As a result, there will be rolled out schedules for all technicians to ensure that staff remain healthy.

Social Distancing
